## DETAILS

**Who would benefit from this course?** This e-learning course is suitable for any member of staff involved with clients in the road transport and logistics industry. In particular Account Managers, Risk Managers and Auditors.

**What students will learn?** The Road Transport and Logistics e-learning course has been designed to provide an insight into the road transport and distribution industry. The invoice finance industry provides finance for many businesses in this sector, and the course is designed to highlight areas of risk that people should be aware of when lending to organisations operating in this sector.

What would be the impact of increased petrol prices on the industry? What are some of the inherent risks in financing a hub and spokes operation?

These are the sorts of areas that we will be looking at in this e-learning course, together with specific invoice financing risks associated with this type of debt.

**Duration:** The course should take students approximately one hour to complete.

**Date & Location:** This course can be taken at any time by the student. A current password is required.

**Course Content:** The course is comprised of four modules, followed by a short multiple choice test.  
**The sections cover the following areas:**  
**The Road Transport and Logistics Industry -** This module introduces the sector and looks at its role in the UK economy.  
**Trends and Issues -** This module looks at the trends and issues companies in the road transport and logistics industry face. The module examines operating costs, fuel prices, labour issues etc and enables the learner to consider the impact of these areas on their clients.  
**Industry Risk -** This module will help students familiarise themselves with the sorts of risks that operators in the industry need to manage.  
**Financing Risk -** This module examines the risks associated with debtor security, hub and spoke operations, groupage and counter claims. It also looks at the risks associated with financial management.  
**Road Transport and Logistics E-learning Test -** When the first four modules have been completed, then the student will take a multiple choice e-learning test. Those students who achieve 50% or greater can print off an ABFA certificate of completion.  
**Cost:** **ABFA Members -** The cost is included in corporate membership of the ABFA, so there is no direct cost involved in students completing the course.  
**Non-ABFA Members -** The cost of the course is £50 per person for non-members of the ABFA. Please note that VAT is not applicable on ABFA Educational Foundation courses.  
**How to book:** **ABFA Members -** Unlike other ABFA courses, because the cost of the course is included within your corporate membership, there is no need to book students onto the course. Passwords are obtainable from your Training Manager.
